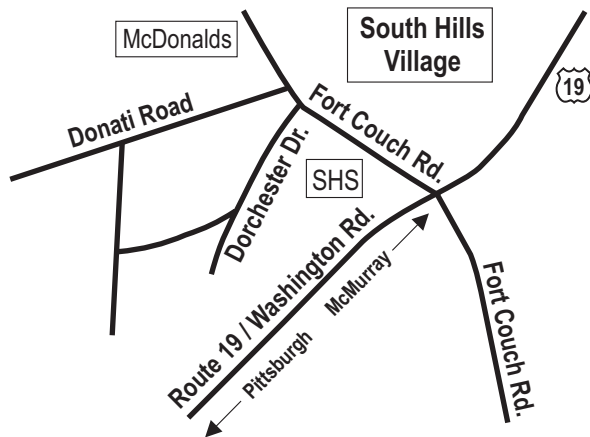

- Degree in other fields with at least one year of full-time paid work experience in a job that involves direct contact with children or adolescents.
- An associates degree or 60 credits toward a bachelor's degree with the equivalent of at least three years of full-time paid work experience in a job that involves direct contact with children or adolescents.
